From the principal's desk

Good morning to all our new Gr. 8 parents and learners. Based on Covid-19, 2020 was a very difficult year with which to content. Unfortunately, we have again been placed on Level 3 lockdown until the 15th of February when a re-evaluation of the situation is expected.

Based on the level 3 regulations and the uncertainty of future decisions, we as management of the school can only manage what is possible.

Subsequently, we have decided to postpone the Gr. 8 orientation program till later. However, we still see the merits of bringing the learners onto our premises a little earlier to introduce them to our school, their form teachers - who will go through the Covid-19 protocols, and to their mentors - the Gr. 12 councillors. We will arrange for half the group to come in on Thursday the 11th of February and the other half on 12th February from 10:00 to 13:00. The learners will be split into groups of no more than 25 with all Covid-19 protocols observed. Learners will be asked to enter through the gate at the admin building where they will be welcomed by their form teachers and the councillors.

The dress code will be informal. Wearing a facemask is compulsory.

Furthermore the learners will receive their textbooks, time table and supporter shirt.

If you already paid your R450 orientation money, you will be reimbursed on your school fee account. I also want to remind parents that some only paid the R 1500 registration money, there is still an amount of R 830 owed for the workbooks and the supporter shirt. Please pay as soon as possible to avoid any awkwardness.

There will be another communication to inform you on which date your child must be at school on 11 and 12 February.
